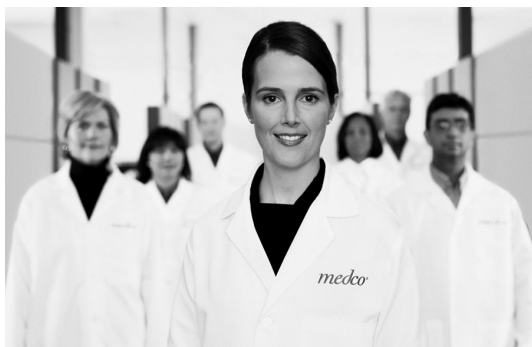

## **KEEPING COSTS DOWN SO YOUR COVERAGE CONTINUES**

Often, your doctor can choose among several drugs to treat a condition, and your plan may prefer some medications over others. These are called *preferred drugs*, and using them helps keep costs down for your plan sponsor. This in turn helps ensure that your plan will provide coverage for the medications you need in the years ahead.

In many cases, using these preferred drugs can also save you money now. For example, brand-name drugs may have generic versions that may have a lower co-payment/co-insurance.

This guide lists medications two ways to help you find some generic, preferred, and nonpreferred brand-name drugs

Within each category, medications are listed in alphabetical order, with generic, preferred brand-name drugs, and nonpreferred brand-name drugs sorted separately:



- G Means a preferred generic medication
- P Means a preferred brand-name medication
- NP Means a nonpreferred brand-name medication

After each nonpreferred brand-name drug, you will find possible generic and preferred brand-name alternatives.
